

ANNEXURE-1
CONDITIONS FOR INSTALLATION OF GANESH IDOLS

1. No construction of any structure of a permanent nature shall be done for installation of Ganesh Idols at any place.
 - a) No Idol shall be installed on public road, pavement, etc.
 - b) The temporary Mandap should be prepared using good quality material, so that it does not collapse due to heavy rush of devotees, wind and heavy rain. The roof should be covered with Tarpaulins. There should not be any scope for animals to enter the Mandap.
 - c) They should use good quality wire for electrical fittings.
2. Playing of loud music in Ganesh Pandals shall not be permitted, so that there is no disturbance to neighbors/students/people who are unwell.
3. Use of loud speaker should not be permitted after 10 pm.
4. No lucky dips or lotteries or coercive collection of funds shall be allowed in the name of the Ganesh Mandap.
5. No political speeches/provocative speeches/slogans or provocative gestures/postures or any other provocative acts, which can hurt the feelings of any section of the public, shall be spoken, raised or displayed at the Ganesh Mandaps.
6. Mandap shall not be used as a place for drinking alcoholic beverages, gambling or any other unlawful and anti-social activities.
7. Adequate care and caution shall be taken to ensure that no inflammable material or fire works are kept at the Ganesh Mandap. Precautions should be taken with regard to lamps illuminated by using oil and aarti within the pandal.
8. To safeguard the Ganesh Mandap/Idol and other articles, a minimum of 3 Volunteers at any point of time shall be available round the clock at the pandal. The names of Volunteers should be entered in the book maintained at the Ganesh Mandap.
9. The Volunteers / Organizers shall promptly inform the police of any important incidents and matters of importance.
10. The required number of Volunteers shall be made available to maintain queues of the devotees who visit Ganesh Mandap for darshan, etc.
11. Conditions imposed by the T.S.S.P.D.C.L., shall be complied with.
12. No serial lighting, decoration lighting or other decorations shall be made outside the Ganesh Mandap.
13. Idols made of Plaster of Paris (POP) shall not be permitted to be immersed in Hussainsagar Lake or any other natural lakes or water bodies, in the city, as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court, issued in W.P Nos 19639 & 28931 of 2022, dated. dt. 21.07.2022. Other directions in the same Order also need to be followed.

14. Immersion of POP Ganesh Idols shall be permitted (i) in baby ponds already constructed by the GH C of (ii) separate areas/ponds which do not result/spread the water pollution into the main water body.
- a) Immersion of Ganesh Idols shall not be permitted from the Tank bund side of the Hussainsager lake
 - b) Non-POP Ganesh idols, which do not have synthetic paint, only shall be permitted, to be immersed through the other side of the Hussain Sagar Lake i.e. P.V Ghat. Secretariat road, Sanjeevaiah Park road etc.
15. The Organizers shall arrange C.C. Surveillance Cameras with recording facility and power backup at all the Ganesh Mandaps and gathering place. It should have the facility to monitor the cameras at one convenient location. Cameras shall also be installed by Organizers with recording facility at all the entries and exit of parking places. This is required as per the Rules under TS Public Safety (Measures) Enforcement Act 2013. Cameras shall also be installed with recording facility at all the Sectors where gathering will be more than 100.

CONDITIONS FOR THE USE OF BOX TYPE SPEAKER

1. Only 2 box type speakers shall be installed at the Mandap, and installation of speakers shall be within the premises of the Ganesh Mandap.
2. Use of loud speakers shall be subject to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the restrictions placed thereupon.

Noise levels prescribed for different areas are given below:

Note:

- I. Day time shall mean from 6 am to 10 pm
 - II. Night time shall mean from 10 pm to 6 am
111. Silence Zone is defined as an area falling within 100 meters around hospitals, educational institutions and courts. The Silence Zones are Zones, which are declared as such by the Competent Authority i.e., Town Planning Department.
3. Loud speakers shall be used only for playing religious and devotional songs.
 4. Loud speakers shall not be used for making political speeches/slogans, or to provoke any person/group of persons.
 5. No loud speaker shall be hired from a person who has not obtained separate Police Clearance from the Asst. Commissioner of Police, to supply the loud speaker.
 6. Loud music should not be played in the Ganesh Pandal so that there is no disturbance to neighbours / students/people who are unwell. Use of loudspeakers should not be permitted after 10 pm

CONDITIONS FOR IMMERSION PROCESSION

1. The Ganesh Utsav Samithi Members may inform the Organizers to engage transportation vehicles for carrying the Ganesh Idols well in advance.
2. The vehicles carrying Idols from South Zone limits should start early on the main immersion day.
3. Distinctive Number allotted by the ACP should be displayed prominently on the vehicle.
4. Only one vehicle will be allowed per Ganesh Idol
5. No loud speaker shall be fixed on the vehicle carrying the idol for immersion.
6. Use of musical system with DJ on vehicles on the immersion day will not be permitted.
7. No person under the influence of alcohol or any other narcotic drugs shall be allowed in the vehicle carrying the Ganesh Idol for immersion or in the procession.
8. The vehicle movement should not affect the free flow of traffic on the road or cause any obstruction.
9. The vehicle carrying the Idol shall not be stopped enroute or near any place of worship causing obstruction to other vehicles and traffic. Vehicle movement will be strictly as per the directions of on the spot Police Officers.
10. No person in the procession shall carry any sticks/swords/knives, fire arms, inflammable material or any other weapons of offence.
11. Sticks used for carrying flags or decorations should not be more than 2 feet in length and should be of split bamboos.
12. Vermillion, Kumkum or Gula! shall not be thrown on the passers-by.
13. No political speeches/provocative speeches/slogans or provocative postures or banners or any other provocative acts which can hurt the feelings of any section of the public shall be raised or displayed during the procession.
14. No fireworks shall be used during the procession.
15. Instructions given by the Police Officers from time to time shall be complied with.
